

How to Write a Basic Level Reflective Paper?

Reflection papers are hard to avoid, no matter which college or university you are in. Essays are some hard nuts to crack. Most of the time, students are either afraid to write an essay or feel it is too hard to [essay writer](#). It is natural to feel both ways because students sometimes are not exposed to proper training and guidance regarding the skill of essay writing. There are several kinds of essays that students are required to write in their academic careers; instance, argumentative essays, reflective essays, descriptive essays, narrative essays, and so on. However, in this blog, you are going to learn the art of writing reflective essays.



In a reflective essay, the writer is required to write a personal approach to another piece of literature "[Dissertation Writing Services](#)". You can be asked to write a reflection essay on a research paper, book, or movie. Your job will not be to provide the bare facts that were already presented in the book, research article, or movie, but you will also be required to provide your thoughts on the subject matter.

The basic structure of a reflective essay is similar to any other essay. You will have to provide the introduction, body paragraphs, and a conclusion. It will be really helpful if we break down the whole concept into little steps. So, let's talk about the introduction, body paragraphs, and conclusion separately.

Just like any other type of essay, the introduction is an important part of the reflection essay. Although it is not a rule you cannot break, it is a good convention to start the introduction with a hook statement. A hook statement is a drug that will grasp the reader's attention at the very outset, and they will keep reading your essay. To be honest, writing a hook statement is an art. It is generally observed that not every [essay writer](#) can write a good hook statement. However, it is also true that practice makes a man perfect. After providing the hook statement, briefly introduce the topic in a few sentences. In the introduction, you are required to express your feelings on the given topic. But make sure you do that according to the academic conventions. You should make sure that you don't get too emotional with this. Similarly, at the end of the introduction, tell the readers what they can expect in the rest of the essay.

When you have written an effective introduction to your reflective essay, now is the time to gear up for the body paragraphs. It depends on the instructions provided by your teacher, but a good convention is to follow a three-paragraph structure. [Buy dissertation](#) and you can describe how the topic, or the literature, or the movie affected you and changed your narrative regarding the topic. This is a task that requires most of the most effort, and many people get stuck during this process. My advice is that you first make a rough draft of the idea with the help of some professional. After successfully writing the body paragraphs of your [essay writer online](#), now is the time to conclude. It is observed that many writers end their essays on the last body paragraph. It is to note that conclusion is an essential part of any essay. Moreover, even if it is not an essay but some other academic paper, the conclusion is mandatory if you have provided the introduction.

The most popular and widely accepted method of writing the conclusion is to start with the thesis statement that you have already provided in the introduction. As you are concluding things, you need to start with the main claim. When I [write my essay](#) or essay, I start with the thesis statement while writing the conclusion. After providing the thesis, summarize the main concept of your essay, that you have already provided in the body paragraphs, and conclude it. However, you do not need to repeat the whole-body paragraphs in the conclusion. You just need to be specific and brief. With a rightly structured conclusion, your essay will become perfect.

There are several aspects of the reflective essay that you should know before you start the work. If you are going to write a reflective essay on a book, it is a good convention that you start with a brief introduction of the author. You must provide a summary of the book, but don't share too much information. Similarly, if it is a novel, you need to put more focus on the main character of the story. Likewise, the most important thing is that you need to react to the literature and not just narrate what you read.

In a nutshell, if you are into higher education, there is no way that you can avoid reflection papers or essays. Your professor might ask you to write a reflection paper on a book, course, movie, or any other form of literature, without teaching you how to do that. Professors assume that you must have learned that in high school. Therefore, always remember all the steps we discussed above. Start with an introduction; provide a good hook statement and some brief insight about the topic and author. In the body paragraphs, reflect on the literature and then sum everything up in conclusion.
